- US - Under-Speed Vehicle** (including what is commonly known as a golf cart), which has three or four wheels, an attainable speed of not more than 20 mph, and a gross vehicle weight of less than 3,000 pounds.

INFORMATION SHEET

The Affidavit for Titling Mini-Truck, Utility Vehicle, and Under-Speed Vehicle (BMV 3722) **does not** qualify the vehicle for registration purposes, but for ownership purposes **ONLY**.

On the Certificate of Title, the vehicle will be designated as one of the following based on what is indicated on the BMV 3722:

- MT - Mini-Truck, which resembles a pickup truck or van with a cargo area/bed at the rear and has four wheels, is propelled by an electric motor with a rated power of 7,500 watts or less or an internal combustion engine with a piston displacement capacity of 660 cc or less, has a total dry weight of 900 – 2,200 pounds, and contains an enclosed cabin and a seat for the operator.
- UV - Utility Vehicle, which was designed with a bed, principally for transporting material/cargo in connection with construction, agricultural, forestry, grounds maintenance, lawn and garden, materials handling, or similar activities.
- US - Under-Speed Vehicle (including what is commonly known as a golf cart), which has three or four wheels, an attainable speed of not more than 20 mph, and a gross vehicle weight of less than 3,000 pounds.
